Grade XII Practical Examinations

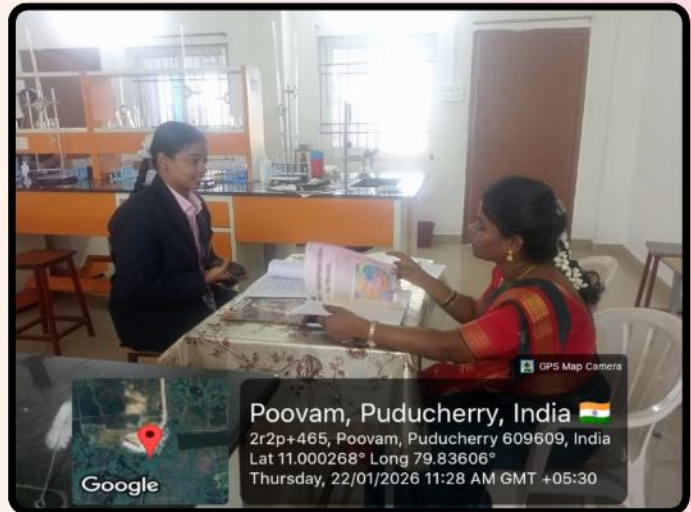
